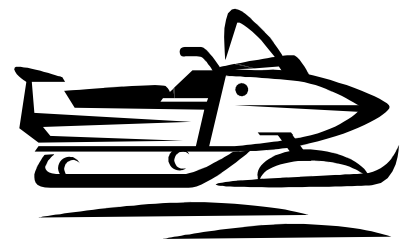
ATTENTION ***** SNOWMOBILE SAFETY CLASS ***** ATTENTION

The Cross Country Cruisers Snowmobile Club will be hosting a snowmobile safety class on January 8, 2010 (Friday) from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. and January 9, 2010 (Saturday) from 9 a.m. until noon. Everyone born after December 31, 1984 must have passed a snowmobile certification class to operate a snowmobile in Wisconsin. The cost is \$10. A driver's license is not a valid alternative.

Before registering for the class, students must obtain a DNR customer number. Locals can call 356-5211 or visit the DNR customer service center on Hwy J (call for times). Everyone can call 1-888-936-7463. Please have your social security number when contacting the DNR.

To register, call Richard Held at 715-358-5313 (have your DNR number before calling). The class will be held at the Cross Country Cruisers new community room (groomer barn) at 1503 Helminski Drive in Arbor Vitae. A snowmobile is not needed to attend. Students must be at least 11 years old to attend the class, but cannot operate alone until they are 12.

REMEMBER — (1) Get your DNR number;(2) Call 715-358-5313; (3) cost is \$10, due on January 8th; (4) parental consent is **mandatory**.
